



## 2018-19 Year 7 Catch up funding

Year 7 Catch up funding allocation for 2018 – 2019 is £14,008.

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

45 students are eligible for the literacy and numeracy catch up. This will mean an allocation of approximately £310 for each of the 45 eligible students.

Of these 47 students: 22 are below a scaled score of 99 in both English and Mathematics, 12 are below a scaled score of 99 in Mathematics and 13 are below a scaled score of 99 in English
